Kiss 'N Ride Safety Rules and Reminders In order to keep our students safe, please follow the procedures outlined below when using the Kiss 'N Ride Lane: Please note that it is extremely important that parents drive slowly and cautiously while on school grounds. The lane closest to the curb is for BUSES ONLY.

The Kiss 'N Ride Lane is the middle lane. Drive your vehicle in this lane and proceed to the furthest point closest to the front doors of the school. Child(ren) must exit your vehicle by the right-hand side door(s) only. Drive to the end of the Kiss 'N Ride Lane within the blue painted lines and cautiously proceed into the Drive-Thru Lane once all children have left your vehicle. Do not park in the Kiss 'N Ride Lane. If you need to enter the school, park your vehicle in the school parking lot or on the street. Do not walk through the Kiss 'N Ride Lane.
